This explores the evolving role of academic administrators in promoting sustainable good governance, drawing on insights from the **past**, **present** and **the future** of academic administration in higher and further education.



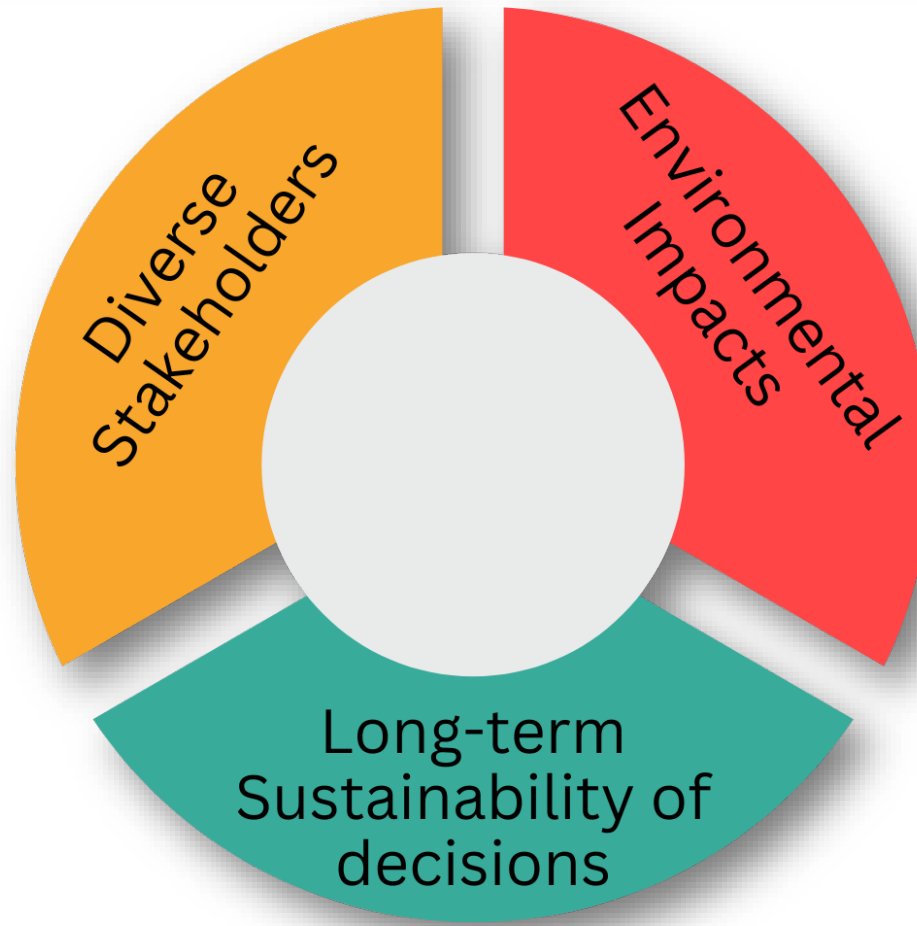


The past

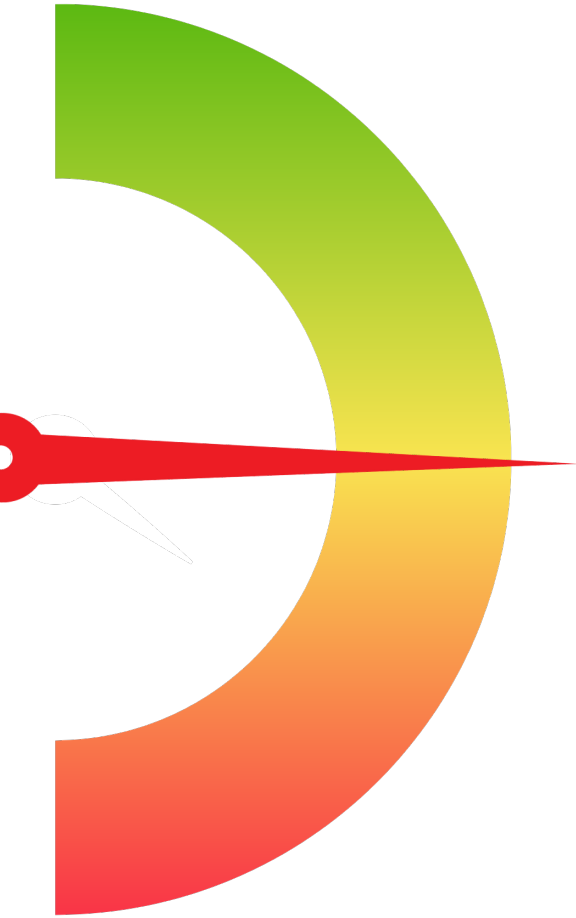
Historically, academic administration in higher education has primarily focused on managing day-to-day operations, ensuring compliance with regulations, and overseeing academic affairs.

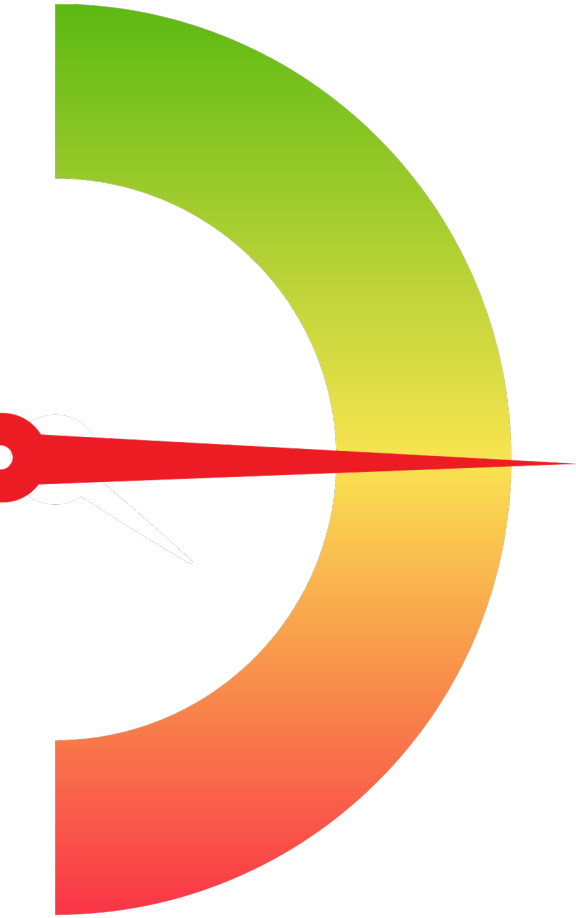

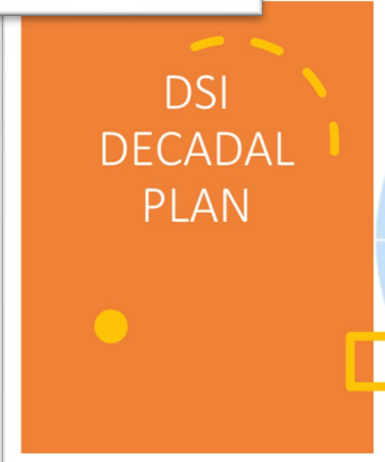
